**** NATIONAL FEDERATION RULES ARE TO BE FOLLOWED ****

ENTRIES: A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four events, no more than two of which shall be individual events.

Individual Events: 6 entries/event

Relays: 1 team per school

ENTRY DEADLINE: **DUE by 12:00 PM, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4TH**

DIVING: Diving will be run in a 2-day format.

Friday – all divers will compete their preliminary & Semi-final dives. The field will then be bracket-cut to the top 20 divers after pre-lims, with no more than 4 divers per team advancing. The entire field will complete their semi-final dives after a 20 minute warm-up. After semi-finals the field will be bracket-cut to top 16. Divers who were cut will complete their lists following a 15-minute warm-up.

Saturday – the the top 16 divers will compete their final dives after the 50 free and the 200 IM Podium awards.

SCORING: Championship scoring for 16 places will be used:

Individual: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

SCORING LIMITED TO MAXIMUM OF 4 PER SCHOOL PER EVENT

AWARDS: **Individual** – 1st - 16th place – (recognized on the podium after the following event)

Relays – 1st – 8th place – (recognized on the podium after the following event)

Team – 1st place – (recognized with WDA Championship sign at conclusion of meet)

ALL CONFERENCE TEAM: The All-Conference team will be selected based upon the number of points the athlete scores for his team in individual events by high point program. The top 20 swimmers and 4 divers will be chosen for the All-Conference Team. If a team does not have representation on the All-Conference team, the athlete scoring the most individual team points will represent that team.

HOSPITALITY/MEETING ROOM: The poolside room will be used. This room is available for all coaches, tournament workers & tournament officials.

WARM-UP LANES: Lane assignments will be emailed prior to the meet. Each team will have one lane in the competition pool and one lane in the cool down pool, with the two smallest teams sharing a lane on each end. Coaches will be responsible for supervision of their swimmers.

SEATING: Teams are asked to sit on the east side of the pool (by the diving pool).
There will be seating areas marked for each team.
Fan seating is open seating. **NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE DIVING BLEACHERS UNLESS DIVING IS IN PROGRESS.**

ADMISSION: Adults - \$8.00 Students - \$5.00 (Admissions will not be charged on Friday evening)

PARKING: Team vehicles (buses) should be parked on the street on the north side of the Mandan Aquatics Center, to allow parking for fans in the parking lot.

CLOTHING APPAREL: T-shirts will be **PRE-ORDER ONLY**. Order form is included.

TRAINER: A trainer will be on duty.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be provided by Mandan High School both days.
